2010 E. C. HALLBECK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION

When the five predecessor unions merged to form the APWU in 1971, the new union decided to maintain an academic scholarship program created in 1969 by the United Federation of Postal Clerks (UFPC) as a tribute to UFPC president E.C. "Roy" Hallbeck. Today the APWU Hallbeck Memorial Scholarship program is a self-perpetuating financial base for providing significant educational assistance to children of APWU union members. It awards \$1,500 for four consecutive years of college to two recipients from each of the five postal regions.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ A senior attending high school or other corresponding secondary school.
- ✓ Child or grandchild, including stepchild or legally adopted child of an active member, Retirees Department member, or deceased member of the American Postal Workers Union.
- ✓ Parent or grandparent must be a full dues paying member or retirees member [as defined in the APWU National Constitution and Bylaws, reference Article 3, Section 1, Section 4(d)] in good standing for at least one year immediately preceding application deadline or must have been a member for one year immediately preceding death.
- ✓ E.C. Hallbeck scholarship recipient must attend an accredited college or university.
- ✓ Must maintain:
 1. "B" average, or
 2. "Pass" if Pass/Fail system

EXCLUSIONS

- Children/grandchildren of all Elected National Officers.
- Sponsor is currently a postal manager.
- Scholarship will be discontinued if the sponsor becomes a postal manager.

SELECTION

The Scholarship Selection Committee [qualified persons in the education field who have no personal ties to the applicants] will select **two Hallbeck winners, one male and one female, from each of the following postal areas:**

AREA 1. CENTRAL	ILLINOIS, INDIANA, IOWA, KANSAS, KENTUCKY, MICHIGAN, MINNESOTA, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA, NORTH DAKOTA, OHIO, SOUTH DAKOTA, WISCONSIN
AREA 2. EASTERN	DELAWARE, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, MARYLAND, NEW JERSEY (EASTERN LOCALS), NEW YORK (EASTERN LOCALS), PENNSYLVANIA, VERMONT, VIRGINIA, WEST VIRGINIA
AREA 3. NORTHEAST	CONNECTICUT, MAINE, MASSACHUSETTS, NEW HAMPSHIRE, NEW JERSEY (NORTHEAST LOCALS), NEW YORK (NORTHEAST LOCALS), PUERTO RICO, RHODE ISLAND, VERMONT, VIRGIN ISLANDS
AREA 4. SOUTHERN	ALABAMA, ARKANSAS, FLORIDA, GEORGIA, LOUISIANA, MISSISSIPPI, NORTH CAROLINA, OKLAHOMA, SOUTH CAROLINA, TENNESSEE, TEXAS
AREA 5. WESTERN	ALASKA, AMERICAN SAMOA, ARIZONA, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO, GUAM, HAWAII, IDAHO, MONTANA, NEVADA, NEW MEXICO, OREGON, SAIPAN, UTAH, WASHINGTON, WYOMING

The Committee will base their evaluations with particular emphasis on leadership and volunteerism, the essay, academic profile, and SAT or ACT score. *For Puerto Rico, the results of the PEAU Examination will be accepted, in lieu of SAT and ACT scores. Decisions of the Selection Committee will be final.*

DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTABILITY

- Once the student recipient is accepted into the academic program of their choice, APWU will deposit the scholarship amount specified with the Student Financial Aid Office of the college. Once begun, disbursements will continue consecutively for the allotted time.
- The student recipient is responsible for providing the APWU with the disbursement request form and student transcript, showing the official grades, prior to APWU generating payment for the next year.
- Scholarship funds will be disbursed to the school for payment of tuition, room, board, books or fees.
- Awards are for continuous years of study at the selected institution. Students must notify the APWU National Secretary-Treasurer before changing academic institutions.
- APWU may discontinue awarding new scholarships; however, once a recipient has been chosen, the scholarship will continue as previously specified.
