Dear Brothers and Sisters:

The National APWU will award fifteen (15) scholarships in 2010, ten academic scholarships and five vocational scholarships to the children and grandchildren of APWU members. If you are interested in receiving information or an application, you can contact the steward in your area, call the union hall, or access the National APWU website at ([www.apwu.org](http://www.apwu.org)). The deadline for submission of applications is **March 15, 2010**.

The Pennsylvania AFL-CIO also awards scholarships for graduating high school seniors, all post-secondary students, and affiliated union members attending an accredited institution. Our local is affiliated with the Pennsylvania AFL-CIO so all Phila. PA local APWU members are eligible. If you are interested in receiving information or an application, you can contact the steward in your area, call the union hall, or access the Pennsylvania AFL-CIO website at ([www.paafclio.org](http://www.paafclio.org)). (The deadline for submission of application is **January 31, 2010**.)

The union plus website offers various benefits for APWU members such as; education scholarships, credit cards, health club discounts, mortgage and real estate assistance, discounts on computers, and other discounts and benefits that may be advantageous to you and your families. The benefits from this website are available to you because you are a member of the APWU. Union Plus is also offering an education scholarship for union members, spouses, and dependent children. Union members must have one year continuous good standing union membership to participate in any Union Plus program. If you are interested in receiving information or an application, you can contact the steward in your area, call the union hall, or access the Union Plus website at ([www.unionplus.org](http://www.unionplus.org)). The deadline for submission of application is **January 31, 2010**.

Each of the three scholarships listed above can be used individually or in conjunction with each other. The APWU scholarship can be used only for children or grandchildren of APWU members, but the Pennsylvania AFL-CIO scholarship and the Union Plus scholarship can be used for children of APWU members as well as any member who may be interested in attending accredited institutions of higher learning.
